

## CHAMPAGNE

### 1 Champagne Moutard Grand Cuvee Brut, France - 55

A bright champagne with a juicy mix of black cherry and candied pink grapefruit. Refined, rich nose which evokes notes of butter, almond and brioche. Lively, elegant and balanced palate with good mouthfeel. Made with 80% Pinot noir, 20% Chardonnay from vines an average age of 20 years old.

### 2 Champagne Veuve Cliquot, Yellow Label, France - 89

A blend of up to 50 different crus mainly Grand and Premier go into the blending of Brut yellow Label. The initial notes of white fruits are followed by toasted brioche and vanilla all held together by a streak of minerality and racy acidity.

### 3 Champagne Moutard Persin Blanc de Blanc, Cotes des bar, France - 85

A fine texture and a pleasant freshness lead to flowery notes and almond hints to the nose. In the mouth, a length of flavour and fresh ending enhanced by a remarkable structure in which can be found notes of lemon and grapefruit. 20 year old vines.

## ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE

### 4 Champagne Moutard prestige rose, France - 85

This champagne is subtle with complexity, the first floral senses blend with the essence of red fresh fruit such as raspberries and wild strawberries evolving towards peppery and spicy aromas. A beautiful Champagne with a distinctive style. This Champagne is particularly popular as an “on it’s own” drinking Champagne.

## SPARKLING WINE

### 5 Domaine Moutard Methode Traditional brut Blanc de Blanc - 36

Sharp, clean acidity with a steely minerality against a fruit profile of granny smiths and zingy citrus fruit. Bready notes from the secondary fermentation give a rich a complexity that rounds off this fantastic wine. Made by a champagne house in the champagne style. Truly great value.

### 6 Botter Prosecco DOC NV, Italy - 125ml 7.50 Bottle 35

This has everything you would expect from a Prosecco... gently sparkling, refreshingly light and easy to drink. Flavours of pear, white peach and apple with a subtle effervescence and a delicate texture.

## ROSÉ

*DRY, CRISP QUAFFERS*

### 7 Grenache/Syrah Rose, Le Grand Noir, France - 33

Intense aromas of raspberry, strawberry and recurrent with a hint of pepper. Rich palette with refreshing bright, red fruit and peppery character.

### 8 Pinot Grigio Rose, Flavorelli, Italy - 175ml 7.25 250ml 9.50 Bottle 28

A crisp refreshing style of rosé wine. Light and soft on the palate easy drinking and bursting with summer berry flavours.

*ON THE SWEETER SIDE*

### 9 White Zinfandel, Frocks and Thrills, USA - 175ml 7 250ml 9 Bottle 27

Bright salmon-pink colour and a fresh nose of raspberry and strawberries.

Juicy yet elegant, soft and creamy, medium to sweet in style.

## WHITE WINES

*LIGHT, FRESH AND DELICIOUS*

### 10 Señorío de Ayanz Blanco, Spain - 175ml 6.50 250ml 8.75 Bottle 26

This is a crisp and balanced dry white wine from the north of Spain. It is fresh with vibrant flavours of tropical fruit.

### 11 Schmitt Söhne Sweet Riesling, Germany - 175ml 9.25 250ml 12.50 Bottle 37

This delicate, moderately light-bodied Riesling has a tasteful, Granny Smith apple characteristic that is crisp and lively on the palate.

### 12 Paseo Sauvignon Blanc, Chile - 175ml 7.25 250ml 9.75 Bottle 29

A crisp and refreshing Sauvignon Blanc with bright citrus and tropical flavours. Dry and lively finish.

### 13 Vinho Verde, Raza, Portugal - 36

At 11.5% alcohol, Raza is a blend of Arinto, Azal and Trajadura. With a fizzy crispness and easy, fruity finish, it is in a familiar style, but clean and invigorating.

### 14 Domaine Denizot Osmoze Sancerre, France - 52

Carefully tended and made, this is a pure, precise and elegant Sancerre. Its beauty is its delicate and tender texture and its fine finish. Unlike New World Sauvignon Blancs, this is a lot more restrained with subtle flavours of gooseberry and nettle.

### 15 Dart Valley Reserve, Sharpham Estate, England - 46

This off-dry and ever popular wine has a light fresh character. Lovely fruit aromas with supple delicate flavours and a toasty oak finish result in a wine ideal for drinking alone or with food.

*AROMATIC, FRUITFILLED AND LUSCIOUS*

### 16 Pinot Grigio, Villa Del Lago - 175ml 7.25 250ml 9.50 Bottle 28

Light green Pinot Grigio. Tropical, with melon, lime and lemon. Some weight, gives way to a refreshing, acidic finish.

### 17 Piesporter Michelsberg, Franz reh and Sohn - 175ml 7.25 250ml 9.50 Bottle 28

From the super-efficient co-operative at Bernkastel this is a deliciously fruity low-alcohol wine that has a fresh fruit character and an attractive off-dry sweetness. ideal as an aperitif or with spicy food.

### 18 Mountain 'Devils Peak' Sauvignon Blanc, South Africa - 175ml 8.75 250ml 11.75 Bottle 35

A bright and racy Sauvignon Blanc with pithy grapefruit, lemongrass and citrus flavours. Clean, dry and supple, it makes a refreshing aperitif.

### 19 Chip off the Old Block Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough,

#### New Zealand - 175ml 9.75 250ml 13 Bottle 39

Love Marlborough Sauvignon’s sunshine brightness and mouth-watering freshness? Then you’ll love this for its vibrant personality and juicy tropical flavours. *175ml 9.75 250ml 13 Bottle 39*

## WHITE WINES

*AROMATIC, FRUIT FILLED AND LUSCIOUS CONTINUED*

### 20 Watervale Chardonnay, Australia - 34

A fruity yet fresh Chardonnay that is easy to enjoy with a gently textured aftertaste.

### 21 Domaine Amélie & Charles Sparr Pinot Gris Sensation, France - 45

Grown biodynamically and lovingly tended by an energetic young Alsace couple, this Pinot Gris is not only a Sensation in name. Welcoming and round, rich fruit and baking spice flavours abound. Enjoy its texture and harmony.

*RICH AND WEIGHTY*

### 22 Chardonnay, Le Petit Noir, France - 175ml 7.75 250ml 10.50 Bottle 31

Yellow green colour, intense aromas of lime, mango, yellow fruit, buttery. Rich palette with yellow fruit lime flavours with fresh balance.

### 23 Laurent Savoye Mâcon-Villages La Chanoise Blanc, France - Bottle 41

From 35-year-old vines on steep, silty clay slopes, this estate-grown Chardonnay is crafted with care and precision. Bright citrus and white flower notes lead into a rich, mineral-driven palate with freshness and length.

### 24 Klippenkop Chenin Blanc, South Africa - 35

A full bodied, dry and powerful white with juicy tropical fruit, fig and melon flavours. There’s a mouth-watering, clean aftertaste.

### 25 Viognier, Minervois, Le Grand, France - 39

A little Chardonnay is added to the blend here giving the wine extra freshness and to compliment its delightful mango and apricot flavours. Unoaked it’s a truly classy example of Viognier.

### 26 Petit Chablis, Louis Moreau, France - 44

Freshness is key here delivering farfrom ‘petit’ flavour and steely minerality. Louis Moreau has been making excellent stylish food friendly and polished Chablis since 1814 winning major awards with his hallmark flinty fresh balanced wines which only the Chardonnay vineyards of Northern Burgundy can deliver every year.

## RED WINES

*JUICY AND UNFUSSY*

### 27 Señorío de Ayanz Tinto, Spain - 175ml 6.50 250ml 8.75 Bottle 26

This smart red packs a lot of wine in its medium bodied frame. Tempranillo is the grape of Rioja but it hails from the neighbouring region of Navarra, giving a well-priced, fruit driven and smooth Spaniard.

### 28 Pinot Noir, Paparuda, Romania - 175ml 7.25 250ml 9.75 Bottle 29

With fresh aromas of strawberry raspberry and caramel on the nose this extremely drinkable light-bodied Pinot has bags of succulentred berry fruit on the palate all wrapped up with lashings of toasted oak on the finish.

### 29 Laurent Savoye Beaujolais Villages Élégance 2023, France - 38

Charming, fruity and fresh, welcome to Beaujolais. Light on its feet with an easy-going personality, it has classic flavours of blue and red fruit and a floral lift.

### 30 Monte Zovo Valpolicella, Italy - 49

This is a mouthwateringly fresh and fragrant Valpolicella with lots of pure red fruit flavours and delightfully manicured tannins.

*SPICY AND WELL ROUNDED*

### 31 Merlot, Le Petit Noir, France - 175ml 7.25 250ml 9.50 Bottle 28

Deep red colour with purple fringe intense aromas of red berry fruit. Crisp blackcurrant flavours married with the flavours of ripe plums form the length of this wine. Balanced tannin finish. Easy drinking red produced for early enjoyment.

### 32 Sea Mountain 'Limestone' Shiraz, South Africa - 175ml 9 250ml 12 Bottle 36

Rich, supple and ripe with flavours of black cherries, fruit cake and sweet festive spices. A characterful Shiraz.

### 33 Crianza, Rioja Santiago, Spain - 175ml 9 250ml 12 Bottle 36

Aged for at least 1 year in American oak barrels followed by six months in bottle this Tempranillo-Garnacha blend is everything you’d expect from a top-quality Rioja Crianza and more. Soft and smoky with warm vanilla and juicy red berry flavours it is delicious enjoyed with roast lamb or tapas dishes.

### 34 Domaine de Courtedune Côtes-du-Rhône Villages, France - 40

A mouth-watering Cotes du Rhone from this respected Chateaufneuf-du-Pape based producer. Juicy and supple with strawberry fruit flavours and floral freshness, leaving you wanting more.

### 35 Miguel Torres Andica Carmenère, Chile - 39

This organically grown Carmenère grape is rich and smooth, dark and seductive. It boasts black fruits, fennel and a lick of vanilla and spice from oak barrel ageing.

### 36 Francois Villard Syrah L'Appel des Sereines, France - 50

A savoury, sexy northern Rhône Syrah that’s fresh and fragrant. In terms of flavours, you’ll get smoky, savoury and a twist of white pepper alongside fruit cake.

## RED WINES

*BIG, BOLD SHOWSTOPPERS*

### 37 Cabernet Sauvignon, La Lejania, Chile - 175ml 7.50 250ml 9.95 Bottle 29.50

An attractive wine full of blackcurrant and bramble fruits with a fullto medium-bodied palate. Compliments most red meat dishes.

### 38 Primitvo, Oltre Passo, Italy - 34

Velvety-smooth and wonderfully dense this rich Italian classic has a nose of roasted plum spice and figs. The mouth feel is silky-soft and decadent with warm toasty notes and a long satisfying finish.

### 39 Malbicho Malbec, Argentina - 175ml 9 250ml 12.50 Bottle 36

Malbicho means someone who defies the rules, challenging the establishment and this juicy Argentine Malbec epitomises that spirit. It’s a medium bodied, succulent style with flavours of red fruit, violets and subtle, toasty vanilla notes.

### 40 GSM, Le Grand Noir, France - 60% Grenache, 35% Shiraz, 5% Mourvedre - 37

This stylish blend of grape varieties gives spicy blackberry flavours, dark plum, black cherry, dark fruit and a hint of pepper. There is also a distinctive mineral perfumed note that comes from tiny berry Mourvedre. Perfect with all full-flavoured meat dishes and ideal with traditional Cumbrian cuisine as well as more international dishes whose flavours might include a note of spice.

### 41 Zinfandel, Wente California, USA - 48

This classic Californian Zinfandel has tantalising aromas of blackberry, black cherry and vanilla from thirteen months spent ageing in oak barriques.

### 42 Klippenkop Pinotage, South Africa - 39

A deep purple tint on the rim with delicious flavours of ripe strawberry banana, juicy plums and rich, red cherry.

### 43 Domaine Font de Courtedune Châteaufneuf-du-Pape, France - 60

A focused and gently nurtured Chateaufneuf-du-Pape that doesn’t rely on muscle and power for its beauty. Instead, it is a perfumed and mid-weight style with an appealing fragrance reminiscent of raspberry and herbs. Dry, long finish.

### 44 Chateau Preuillac Medoc, Bordeaux, France - 59

Red fruit and blackberry aromatics lead seamlessly to a plum and cherry-laden palate with a slightly smoky finish. Plenty of structured layers here.

## DESSERT WINES

### 45 Rutherglen Muscat, Stanton and Kileen (35cl Bottle), France

#### 50ml 4.75 100ml 9.45 Bottle 33

This late-harvested lightly fortified Muscat comes from Rutherglen in Victoria. Floral Muscat aromas pave the way for fruitcake and Demerara sugar flavours all balanced out by refreshing acidity and mouth-coating softness. This is a world-class pudding wine.

### 46 Elysium Black Muscat, California (35cl Bottle), USA

#### 50ml 6.25 100ml 12.25 Bottle 43

Virtually black in colour, with a rose-like aroma, very intense on the palate and full of fantastic rich velvety fruit. One of the few wines that can stand up to chocolate puddings. Or try it poured over ice cream for the ultimate after-dinner treat!

## PORT 50ml

### Portal Fine Ruby, Portugal - 5.75

Portal Fine Ruby is elegant, lively and with plenty of rich young fruit. It is aged for three years in large wooden vats keeping it as fresh as protected from oxidation has possible.

### Graham’s Six Grapes, Portugal - 6.75

Deep golden-amber in colour and a complex orange peel and cinnamon aroma with prunes raisins and figs. This fine Graham’s aged Tawny is matured in seasoned oak casks to achieve it’s full and generous flavour with a long clean finish.

### Graham’s 10 Year Tawny, Portugal - 7.75

Complex nutty aromas, combined with hints of honey and figs. On the palate rich, mature fruit flavours; beautifully mellowed; with a luscious, long finish.

### Warre’s Single Quinta 2005, Portugal - 11

A delicious single quinta port with flavours of mulberry raisin and prunes. Warre’s Quinta da Cavadinha has matured gracefully adding complex flavours and a mellow feel. It’s ready for drinking now.
